1. Cutting and overwriting should be avoided and the entries should be made in legible hand
2. Rules and regulations prescribed in the enclosed format for Edufest must be followed.
3. For change of participants(s), please inform the convener well in advance.

RULES AND REGULATION

1. Solo song

- Entry of one participant only.
- Minimum time is not less than 4 minutes and not more than 5 minutes.
- Filmy or non-filmy song are allowed either on track or live music.
- Two accompanists are allowed in case of live music.
- In case of karaoke participants will bring his/her song in CD with one folder only. No other item should be there in that particular CD. Pen-drives are not allowed.
- Vulgarity or obscenity must be avoided in action, costume and gesture of the Singing or else it will lead to the disqualification.

2. Solo Dance

- Entry of one participant only either on track music or live.
- The track played can be filmy or non-filmy.
- Minimum time is not less than 4 minutes and not more than 6 minutes.
- Three accompanists are allowed in case of live music.
- Vulgarity or obscenity must be avoided in action, costume and gesture of the Dance or else it will lead to the disqualification.

2. Group Dance

- A College/Institute can send a team of maximum 10 participants in case live music performance otherwise only 8 participants will be allowed in case of music on track.
- The dance can be folk general or any acceptable form.
- The track played can be filmy or non filmy.
- Minimum time is not less than 7 minutes and not more than 9 minutes.
- Recorded Music and Fusion of music is allowed.
- Vulgarity or obscenity must be avoided in action, costume and gesture of the Dance or else it will lead to the disqualification.

4. Elocution

- Each college will be represented by one speaker.
- Medium of expression will be Hindi or English.
- Minimum time is not less than 4 minutes and not more than 6 minutes.
- Paper reading will not be allowed.

Topics are as under:-

1. Role of teacher in nation building.
2. A teacher' from gurukul to convent school.
3. The changing relations of teacher-taught.
4. The present education system and its worth.

5. Poetic Recitation

- Each College can send one participant only.
- Medium of poetry recitation shall be Hindi or English.
- Maximum time allowed to each participant shall be four minutes while minimum is three minutes.
- The contents of the poem should not be vulgar or cheap.

6. Debate

- A college/Institute can send one team comprising of 2 speakers boys, girls or both.
- The medium of expression will be Hindi or English. One speaker shall speak for the motion and other against. It must be intimated to the Stage secretary before the commencement of the competition.
- The subject of the Debate will be announced 24 hours before the programme and the participants shall speak after drawing lots to decide, who is to speak first, second and so on.
- The time allotted to each participant is not less than 4 minutes and not more than 6 minutes.
- The first speaker will be the leader of the house and he/she also wind up the Debate.
- Vulgarity or obscenity must be avoided in action and gesture.

7. Figure Making

- Each College/Instt. can send one participant.
- Event will be conducted 'On the Spot'.
- Duration will not be more than 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- Participants will bring their own material as per need.
- The subject will be given on the spot.

8. Pot Decoration

- Each College/Instt. can send one participant.
- Event will be conducted 'On the Spot'.
- Duration will not be more than 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- Participants will bring their own material as per need.
- The pots will be provided by the Youth Welfare Department on the spot.

9. Best Out of Waste

- Each College/Instt. can send two participants to perform jointly.
- The topic of the event will be announced 24 hours before the commencement of the event.
- Event will conduct on the spot.
- Duration will not be more than 2 hours 30 minutes.
- Participants are required to bring their own Waste material for operating event.
- Participants will use only the waste material which will be examined by judges before start.

10. Group Improvisation (Curriculum Based Skit)

- A College can enter only one team up to 6 participants.
- Maximum time allowed is not less than 8 minutes and not more than 10 minutes.
- Use of Make-up, drapery and background music is allowed.
- The medium of the skit can be in Hindi only.
- Two accompanists are allowed.
- Vulgarity and obscenity will be disqualification.
- It is hereby impressed on all the Directors/Principals to screen the script of the skit to be staged and ensure that nothing should be vulgar, obscene in the skit.

11. Rangoli

- Each College/Instt. can send one participant.
- Event will be conducted 'On the Spot'.
- Duration will not be than 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- Participants will bring their own material. This art is known differently in various reasons such as Mandna, Alpana, Alekhan, Kolam, Rangoli etc. For this the medium and form for expression can be free hand, pictorial and descriptive.
- Only one medium shall be used- Poster Colours or Flower Petal or Saw-dust or Pulses or Rice without Pasting.
- The Participants shall have to prepare a rangoli within the space provided by organizers/judges.

12. Teacher on Leave

- Each College/Instt. can send one participant.
- The topic will be given to the participant 'on the Spot'.
- The expression/presentations should be relevant to the subject of the teacher on leave an according to the class.
- Core- teaching skills like skill of questioning, skill of illustration with example, skill of explanation, skill of stimulation etc. are to be followed.
- Interaction with the students is to be observed.
- Maximum time allowed will be 10 minutes.

13. Quiz

- Each Institute can send a team of two persons.
- The medium of the Quiz will be English or Hindi.
- There will be a written preliminary round and teams will be elected for the final.
- Finals will be oral.
- The Specific rules regarding evaluation procedure, time reply a particular answer and the type of round will be given before the actual start of the competition.
- The decision of Quiz Master will final regarding the correctness of the answer.
- The Quiz will be based on the General awareness of B.Ed syllabus.

14. Aaj ka Vichar

- Each College/Instt. can send one participant.
- The participants have to write it on the white marker board. Along with that, it should be submitted in form of A4 Size paper in written form.
- Theme will be given to students 'On the Spot' (10 minutes before the event).
- Idea should be widely accepted and according to the theme.
- Neat and Clean handwriting will carry bonus marks.

15. My Dream Teaching Aid

- Each College/Instt. can send one participant.
- Teaching aid should be according to the level of students and teaching subjects.
- Teaching aid should be properly visible and audible.
- Teaching aid should convey the message for which it has been prepared.
- Student should bring the material with them, with the help of which he or she has to prepare the teaching aid.
- Time limit will be 30 minutes.

16. Duet Song (Filmi/Non-Filmi):

- A College/Institution may enter two participants only (1 male & 1 female or both)
- Time allotted not less than 4 minutes and not more than 5 minutes.
- Three accompanists are allowed.
- Recorded Track/Music is allowed.
- The theme should not be cheap or vulgar.
- Judgement will be based on the qualities like, voice, swara, tal, composition and general impression

17. Photography

- A college/institution can send one participant.
 - The participant has to bring his/her own digital camera of not more than 12 mega pixels.
 - The digital camera should have memory card which will be formatted by the judges before the commencement of the contest.
 - The time limit will be 2.30 hours.
 - The participant has to capture 5 photographs on the theme announced on the spot by the judges.
 - The additional instructions will be announced on the spot.
 - Digital images are evaluated on the basis of (1) IMPACT, (2)COMPOSITION, (3)TECHNICAL QUALITY AND (4) SUITABILITY FOR THE SPECIFIC THEME.
- Mimicry:
 - A College/Institute can enter one participant.
 - Each participant will be given maximum 5 minutes time but not less than 3 minutes for the performance.

- Participants may create mimicry sound of machines and speeches of well-known persons etc.
 - Marking will be based on, 1) Skill of imitation, 2) Variety of sound and voices imitated, 3) Presentation.
- **Mehandi**
 1. Each College/Institution can send one participant only.
 2. The competitors shall bring their own material.
 3. The duration of the item is one hour only.
 4. An oral explanation will be asked on the spot.
 5. Herbal Heena to be used.

● **20. On the Spot Painting:**

- Each College/ Institution. can send one participant.
- Painting will be 'On The Spot'. The subject of the painting will be landscape, portrait or composition which will be given by Organizer/Judges.
- Size of the painting will be half imperial size drawing paper i.e. 22" x 15", which will be got signed by the Organizers/Judges before the start of the competition
- Painting can be done in oil, water, pastel/poster colours.
- The competitors shall bring their own material.
- Two hours and 30 minutes shall be allowed to each participant
