Clarification regarding admission Sub:

Sir/Madam.

A number of queries are received in connection with various aspects of admissions for 2015-16 from the Colleges/Individuals. Some of such queries have been compiled and clarification about the same are summed up as under for your information and necessary action:-

i) Whether there is any bar on promotion to the 3rd Semester of 3-Year Degree Course/ 2-Year PG Course who have not qualified certain number of papers of a particular semester or passed a

particular semester?

Ans: During the session 2015-16 there is no such restriction on promotion to the 3rd or 5th or 7th Semester as the case may be.

ii) If a candidate has not passed all the papers of 1st to 6st semester (first module of 5-Year Integrated courses, can he /she be promoted to the 7th Semester?

Ans: The promotion rule of having first module (1st to 6th Semesters) passed is applicable on the students who sought admission in the Session 2014-15 in 1st semester of the Course.

iii) The candidate who has qualified the qualifying examination and has a gap of more than two years

can he/she be granted admission to a course?

Ans: Yes. Such candidate can be granted admission provided he/she submits an undertaking that during the gap period he/she has not undergone any regular course or otherwise and has not indulged in any illegal activities.

iv) Can a candidate, who after seeking admission left the course in between and sought admission in

some other course or otherwise, be allowed to seek admission to continue the said course ?

Ans: Such candidates can be allowed admission, only if he/she is able to complete the course within the maximum period prescribed for completing a course which is the duration prescribed for a course +3 years.

v) Can the vacant seats in reserved categories be converted into general categories?

Ans: Vacant seats in reserved categories after the 3rd counselling shall be converted into general category and filled up strictly on the basis of merit. There is no need to send such cases to the University for approval.

vi) Can a candidate who is absent in first or second round of counselling be considered for admission

in the subsequent counsellings?

Ans: Any candidate, who fails to turn up for Counseling at his/her turn, will be considered for the remaining seats at the time he/she reports for counseling. Such candidates, who do not get admission in one rounds of counseling, shall be eligible for admission in subsequent rounds of counselling, if seats are available.
