It has been noticed that some of the affiliated colleges have admitted the students who have passed their lower examinations from other colleges of this University without having permission of Inter-College Migration from the University as per existing rules mentioned at Page No. 86 of Calendar Vol. 2 Part A are as under:

A students who has joined one college of the University and wished to migrate to another college of the University during the same course shall be permitted to do so may if the Principals of both the colleges agree to the migration and the application is forwarded to the Registrar for sanction through the Principals of both the colleges, accompanied by a fee of Rs. 500/which shall not be refunded.

The matter has been considered by the University authorities and it has been ordered to accept all such type of requests of students as well as colleges as one time exception with the clear stipulation that the college will send request of such students with their Regn. No., name of previous College and deposit the Inter-College Migration fee of Rs. 500/- per student to the University alongwith Registration to urns as per University schedule.
