Sub: Withdrawal of Provisional Affiliation in respect of I.B. Women College of Education & Management, Northern Bye Pass, Near Sector 1 Telephone Exchange, Ram Gopal Colony, Rohtak (Haryana) for B.Ed. regular course w.e.f. the session 2012-13.

Sir/Madam,

Pursuant to the decision of Executive Council vide resolution no. 21 of its meeting held on 12.10.2012, a show cause notice dated 29.11.2012 was served upon you asking to show cause as to why the provisional affiliation granted to your college be not withdrawn. Your written reply/representation, if any, in response to this notice was to be reached to the Registrar of this University within 21 days. It was also informed to you that non-reply to this show cause notice would be presumed that you accept the decision and have nothing to say in this regard and a final decision as considered just and appropriate under the University Rules would be taken by the competent authority.

The above stipulated period of 21 days had been elapsed and nothing was heard from the society as well as Principal. However the copy of show cause notice addressed to the Principal of your college received back as undelivered with the remarks that "left without address returned to sender" accordingly a reminder letter dated 24.12.2012 was again sent to the President directing him to submit the reply to

the show cause notice within 7 days from the date of issue of this letter failing which further action as already intimated shall be taken in the matter.

Even after expiry of above stipulated period of 7 days no reply to the show cause notice received neither from the President nor from the Principal of the College. The NRC of NCTE in its 211th meeting held from February 19th to 21st 2013 also decided that the order of withdrawal of recognition shall stand for derecognize courses. The formal letter in this regard for with standing its earlier order of derecognized course i.e. B.Ed. has also received (copy enclosed).

In the light of the above decision of the Central Body i.e. NCTE and non receipt of reply to the show cause notice from you, the matter was placed before the Academic Council for consideration and decision. The Academic Council vide resolution no. 27 in its meeting held on 15.04.2013 has resolved as under :-

“RESOLVED TO RECOMMEND TO THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL :

- (i) **THAT PROVISIONAL AFFILIATION OF I.B. WOMEN COLLEGE OF EDUCATION AND MANAGEMENT, RAM GOPAL COLONY, NEAR SECTOR- 1 TELEPHONE EXCHANGE, ROHTAK BE WITHDRAWN IN VIEW OF THE DECISION TAKEN BY THE NRC OF NCTE IN ITS 211TH MEETING HELD FROM FEBRUARY 19TH TO 21ST 2013 AND THE ORDERS CONVEYED TO THE UNIVERSITY VIDE LETTER NO. F.NRC/NCTE/HR-1570/211TH MEETING/2012-39110 DATED 14.03.2013 AND ALSO IN VIEW OF NON SUBMISSION OF REPLY/REPRESENTATION TO THE SHOW CAUSE NOTICE DATED 29.11.2012 SERVED UPON THE PRESIDENT AS WELL AS PRINCIPAL OF THE COLLEGE.**
- (ii) **THAT ADMISSIONS TO THE B.ED. COURSE MADE IN THE COLLEGE FOR THE SESSION 2012-13 IN TERMS OF INTERIM DIRECTION/ORDER DATED 19.12.2012 OF THE HON'BLE PUNJAB AND HARYANA HIGH COURT PASSED IN CWP NO. 22676 OF 2012 BE CONTINUED SUBJECT TO THE FINAL OUTCOME OF THE WRIT PETITION AND REVIEW APPLICATION/APPEAL AGAINST THE ABOVE DECISION OF THE HON'BLE COURT FILED BY THE UNIVERSITY.**

The above recommendation of Academic Council were subsequently approved by the Executive Council of this University vide Reso. No. 26 of its meeting held on 26.04.2013 (copy enclosed).

In term of the above decision of the Executive Council, I have been directed to convey you that the provisional affiliation of I.B. Women College of Education &

Management, Ram Gopal Colony, Near Sector – 1 Telephone Exchange, Rohtak has been withdrawn w.e.f. the session 2012-13 and admissions to the B.Ed. course made for the session 2012-13 in terms of interim direction/orders dated 19.12.2012 of the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court passed in CWP No. 22676 of 2012 be continued subject to the final outcome of the writ petition and review application/appeal against the above decision of the Hon'ble Court filed by the university.

ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution I.B. Women College of Education and Management, Opposite Sec.1, Telephone Exchange, Rohtak, District- Rohtak, Haryana was granted recognition for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred Only) students vide NRC order no. F.NRC/NCTE/HR-1570/2008/59952-58 dated 02.09.2008

AND WHEREAS, after grant of recognition the institution was inspected under section 17 of the NCTE Act. The VT report was placed in the 141st meeting of the NRC. The NRC considered the VT. The reply received from the institution was placed before the NRC and the NRC in its 161st meeting decided that "VT may be sent again." The VT report was received but the same was not considered in the NRC.

AND WHEREAS, the institution filed a writ petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and consequent upon the stay of the Hon'ble High Court, the decision of the NRC to withdraw the recognition was kept in abeyance. Subsequently the said writ petition was disposed of and dismissed, Thereafter, the institution approached the Hon'ble Supreme Court and filed a Civil Appeal No. 3505 of 2012 (arising out of SLP (Civil) No. 233 of 2011 and the apex court vide order dated 12.04.2012 directed that :-

Para 1-31 (as per the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court)

Para 32 In what we have discussed above, in our considered view, interest of justice shall be sub-served, if the Council causes inspection of all the institutions concerned in these Appeals-which approached Madhya Pradesh High Court and Delhi High Court- being made as provided in Section 13 of the 1993 Act within six weeks from today. The Council shall communicate to the concerned institutions the result of such inspection and call upon the institutions to make up the deficiencies, if found during such inspection, as early as may be possible. With regard to the institutions where no deficiencies are found in the course of inspection or the institutions which make up deficiencies brought to their notice as a result of inspection, the Regional Committee shall issue appropriate order withdrawing order of de-recognition. In respect of the institutions which do not make up the deficiencies within time granted by the Council, the order of withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee shall stand.

Para 33 Civil Appeals are disposed of as above with no order as to costs.

Para 34 In view of the above, Interlocutory Applications, if any, do not survive and stand disposed of.

AND WHEREAS, in pursuance of the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the NCTE Hq conducted the inspection of the institution under section 13 of the NCTE Act, 1993 and communicated certain deficiencies to the institution vide letter No. F. No. 93-15/2012/NCTE/Sec.13/ Inspection/A55972 dated 06.08.2012.

AND WHEREAS, the institution did not submitted its reply to the deficiency letter dated 6.8.2012 to the NRC, NCTE and the whole case was considered by the Northern Regional Committee in its 207th meeting held from 27th - 30th November, 2012 in view of the direction of the NCTE Hqr. following the directions of the Hon'ble Apex Court in the Civil Appeal No. 3505 of 2012 (arising out of S.L.P. (Civil) No. 233 of 2011 in light of provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations. The Northern Regional Committee decided the following:-

The Committee after going through all relevant records, report of the NCTE Hq. under section 13 of the NCTE Act, 1993, deficiencies pointed out by the NCTE Hq., viz-a-viz provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations observed that the following deficiencies were communicated by the NCTE Hq. for compliance to the institution and the deficiencies were communicated to the institution vide letter No. F.No.93-24/2012/NCTE/ Sec.13/Insp./A55973 dt.06.08.2012 by the NCTE Hq.

- and second floors of a building. But the map is for single only. Further the room dimensions mentioned in the plan do not tally with the ones reported by the inspection team.
2. The building plan has been approved only on 05.03.2012 by Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Rohtak. The institution is required to furnish approved building plan submitted at the time of grant of recognition.
 3. The institution submitted building completion certificate issued by Executive Officer, Municipal Council on 05.03.2012. It mentioned (83330 sq.ft. of built up area on each Ground, First and Second floors. Hence the total built up area on 3rd floors would be 2,49,990 sq.ft. a much exaggerated area where as the building plan mentioned only 2500 sq.mts. (26,910 sq.ft.) of built area only.
 4. Labs, Library, Class rooms, and Multipurpose hall etc.: (a) Desks and chairs are not according to the requirement of the B.Ed. students. (b) The institution has not submitted supporting documents like bills and stock register entry in proof of having adequate facilities in various labs and library.
 5. Faculty: (a) Staff has not been approved by the University and the teachers did not show original certificates to the inspection team (b) Appointed Principal does not have requisite teaching experience as per NCTE norms (c) Not appointed lecturers for teaching science and math methodology subjects. (d) It has not submitted certificates of academic qualifications and teaching experience for ascertaining their eligibility as per norms. (e) The selection Committee minutes of the faculty submitted by the institution does not even mention the date of selection and also the selection committee does not comprise university representative. (f) Not submitted any proof paying the salary through Bank. (g) CPF/PPF to the staff is not maintained.
 6. The land is not transferred in the name of the institution.
 7. FDRs are not maintained jointly with NCTE.

In addition the institution was issued a Show Cause notice for taking disciplinary action amounting to withdrawal of affiliation of the institution by the M.D. University.

The institution did not reply to the deficiencies pointed out by the NCTE Hq. under Section 13 of the NCTE Act, 1993 as per the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Therefore, the NRC decides to seek above details/clarification & issue Show Cause Notice under section 17 of the NCTE Act, to the institution on the above points and direct the institution to submit the reply accompanied with an affidavit as per provisions of the NCTE Rules & Regulations within 30 days.

Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 15.01.2013

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted its reply vide letter dated 09.02.2013 and the same was considered by the Northern Regional Committee in its 211th meeting held from February 19th to 21st, 2013 and NRC decided that:-

The Northern Regional Committee in its 207th meeting held from 27th – 30th November, 2012 considered the case in view of the direction of the NCTE Hqr. following the directions of the Hon'ble Apex Court in the Civil Appeal No. 3505 of 2012 (arising out of S.L.P. (Civil) No. 233 of 2011) in light of provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations.

The Committee after going through all relevant records, report of the NCTE Hq. under section 13 of the NCTE Act, 1993, deficiencies pointed out by the NCTE Hq., viz-a-viz provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations observed that the deficiencies were communicated by the NCTE Hq. for compliance vide letter No. F.No.93-17/2012/NCTE/Sec.13/Insp./A55972 dt.06.08.2012

The NRC in its 207th meeting noted that the institution did not reply to the deficiencies pointed out by the NCTE Hq. under Section 13 of the NCTE Act, 1993 as per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Therefore, the NRC decided to issue a show cause notice to the institution. The same was issued to the institution on 15.1.2013.

The NRC finally considered the matter and noted that inspite of the NCTE Hq. letter dated 6.8.2012 and subsequent SCN issued by the NRC on 15.1.2013, the institution did not reply to the deficiencies pointed out by the NCTE Hq. under Section 13 of the NCTE Act, 1993 as per the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.



Therefore, the NRC decides that the order of withdrawal of recognition stands for derecognized courses.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under the NCTE Act, 1993, the recognition of the institution shall stand withdrawn for the B.Ed. course of the institution namely **I.B. Women College of Education and Management, Opposite Sec.1, Telephone Exchange, Rohtak, District- Rohtak, Haryana** as per the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

If the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under sections 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the issue of this order.
