Sir.

An inspection committee was appointed to decide the matter of grant of provisional

On the basis of the report of the Inspection Committee which visited your proposed institute on 12.06.2013 to verify the various infrastructural facilities provided for running M.B.A. with 180 seats and in view of approval of the AICTE, the Vice-Chancellor has been pleased to grant provisional affiliation to Delhi Global Institute of Management, Faridabad for running MBA with 180 seats w.e.f. the session 2013-14, subject to the approval of the Academic Council/ Executive Council of the University, which will be binding on your Institute.

The above provisional affiliation is subject to fulfillment of all the observations/ shortcomings pointed out by the Inspection Committee in its report dated 13.06.2013 (copy

The admissions to the said course shall be made through the competent authorized authority.

The above provisional affiliation is further subject to the following mandatory conditions:

- 1. The Institute shall constitute Governing Body as per Central Body/University norms.
- 2. The admissions will not exceed beyond the sanctioned intake.
- 3. The teaching and all other staff shall be appointed through properly constituted Selection Committee and with prior approval of the University as per University Norms. CPF scheme must be introduced. Service rules for teaching/non-teaching staff should be framed and a copy be sent to the University
- 4. The faculty shall be appointed as per Central Body/AICTE norms in the pay scales prescribed by it from time to time.
- 5. The fee structure prescribed by the State Govt./ University shall be strictly followed.
- 6. All Academic, physical and other infrastructural facilities shall be continued to be provided/upgraded by the institute as prescribed by the Central Body/AICTE/University
- 7. The institute shall furnish requisite documents and reports as called for by the University from time to time in order to ensure proper maintenance of the infrastructural facilities and
- 8. The information furnished in respect of above courses shall be factual and correct. In the event of any information found to be false, misleading or suppressed, the provisional affiliation shall be withdrawn by the University without any notice.
- 9. In the event of non compliance of the University Act/Statutes/Ordinance/Rules and Regulations and any other instructions/guidelines issued from time to time, the University shall be free to withdraw the provisional affiliation and all liabilities arising out of such a withdrawal would solely lie on the concerned society/institute
- 10. The institute shall follow the mode of selection of candidates for admissions as approved by the Central Body/State Govt./University.
- 11. The institute shall provide all Academic and Infrastructural facilities including classrooms, hostels, library, laboratories, workshops, play grounds and other amenities required for the smooth conduct of its affairs as per Central Body/AICTE/University Norms.

12. The Trust/ Society shall not change the location of the institute without prior approval of

13. Building: The entire building of the College will be at the disposal of the Controller of Examinations for the purpose of Conduct of examinations as and when, the 'Centre of Examination (for theory and practical both) is created, it will be obligatory for the Principal too provide necessary infrastructure for smooth conduct of examination.

14. Examination Centre: Creation of an Examination Centre in the College will be at the discretion of the Controller of Examinations. The Centre of examinations for the students studying in the College can be shifted to any other College. In such a situation, it will be the responsibility of the institution to make arrangements for transporting the students to the Centre of Examinations without any extra charges from the students. Similarly, the University can also shift the students of other Colleges/Institutes to the College/Institution under reference for which necessary infrastructure will have to be provided by the

15. Staff: For the purpose of conduct of examinations, the services of entire teaching and non-teaching staff will be at the disposal of the Controller of Examinations. The examination duties can be assigned to any member of teaching and non-teaching staff which will have to be complied with, in the interest of smooth conduct of examinations.

16. Strong Room: There will be a strong Room in the College at the prime location adjacent to the office of the Principal to keep the confidential material of the University as and when required. The Strong Room will essentially have double lock system.

You are, therefore, requested to complete the above requirement/conditions and conditions/requirements mentioned in the report of the inspection committee (enclosed with letter). You are requested to submit the compliance of above before the commencement of the classes to the university so that further action may be taken accordingly. In case of non compliance of above conditions/ requirements, and the conditions pointed out in the inspection report, the University shall have the right to refuse the extension of provisional affiliation to the institute for the next

Memo:

The admission brochure for the session 2013-14 for UG/PG courses has already been circulated to the quarters concerned. The corrected admission brochure has already been sent to the colleges running BHM/BTM/BJMC/MCA courses and the correction has already been carried out in the admission brochure uploaded on the University website. However, it is again clarified that the lateral entry in BHM/BTM appearing at Page-20 be read upto 2nd year and the provisions mentioned in last three lines (i.e. upto 10% of total intake. In case of Diploma from other University/Board 70% syllabi should match with 1st year of BTM/BHM)-- be treated as deleted.

The course mentioned at Sr. No. 6 page 20- Bachelor of Journalism and Mass Communication (Hons.) be read as Bachelor of Journalism and Mass Communication.

The word "Hons." be treated as deleted.

Since the admissions to MCA course are to be made by the HSTES, the eligibility conditions prescribed by the HSTES shall prevail. Hence eligibility conditions given for admissions in MCA course at page 24 be treated as deleted. Only the lateral entry admissions shall be made by the Institutes as per eligibility conditions prescribed by the University:-

"Bachelor's degree of minimum three year's duration in BCA, B.Sc.(IT/CS) or any other examination recognized by MDU Rothak as equivalent thereto having 50% marks (45% for SC/ST of Haryana only) in aggregate with Mathematics as a course at 10+2 level or

Graduate level."
