Abstract

The abstract should summarize the content of the paper. Try to keep the abstract below 150 words. Do not have references or displayed equations in the abstract. Paper form is a necessary condition for its publication, as well as its content.

Keywords: Author Guide, Article, Camera-Ready Format, Paper Specifications, Paper Submission.

Illustrations or pictures: All halftone illustrations or pictures should be clear black and white prints. Supply the best quality/high resolution illustrations or pictures possible.

2.1 Footnotes

Footnotes should be typed in single-line spacing at the bottom of the page and column where it is cited. Footnotes should be rare.

1. Introduction

The text must be in English. The submitted typeset scripts of each contribution must be in their final form and of good appearance because they will be printed directly. This document is set in 10-point Times New Roman.

3. Tables, Figures and Equations

3.1 Tables and Figures

To insert “Tables” or “Figures”, please paste the data as stated below. All tables and figures must be given sequential numbers (1,2, 3, etc.) and have a caption placed below the figure (“Fig Caption”) or above the table (“Fig Table”) being described, using 8pt font and please make use of the specified style “caption” from the drop-down menu of style categories

2. Headings and Footnotes

1. Major headings are to be column centered in a bold font without underline. They should be numbered.
2. ‘Headings and Footnotes’ at the top of the paragraph is the main heading with the font size 12 of Times New Roman.

- [2] A. Name, and B. Name, "Journal Paper Title", Journal Name, Vol. X, No. X, Year, pp. xxx-xxx.

Keywords: From 4 to 6 keywords should follow the abstract as a subheading: Key words, of the Abstract.
