2. Headings and Footnotes

- 1. Major headings are to be column centered in a bold font without underline. They should be numbered.
- 2. 'Headings and Footnotes' at the top of the paragraph is the main heading with the font size 12 of Times New Roman.

2.1 Subheadings

Subheadings should be same as the above headings "2.1 Subheadings" with font size 11. They should start at the left-hand margin on a separate line.

The top of this paragraph illustrates a subheading.

Title: The title should be centered across the top of the first page and should have a distinctive font of 18 points Century. It References should be in bold font and in lower case with initial capitals.

Author' Name and Address: The authors' names and addresses [2] A. Name, and B. Name, "Journal Paper Title", should be centered below the title. These lines should be 9 points Times New Roman.

Keywords: From 4 to 6 keywords should follow the abstract as a subheading: Key words, of the Abstract.

Illustrations or pictures: All halftone illustrations or pictures should be clear black and white prints. Supply the best quality/high resolution illustrations or pictures possible.
