Course Types:

• Core (C):

There are Core Courses in every semester. These Courses are to be compulsorily studied by a student as a core requirement of a Programme in a said discipline of study.

• Discipline Specific Elective (DSE):

Soft core is a course which can be chosen from a pool of papers. It will be supportive to the discipline of study and mandatory as per course curriculum.

Foundation Course (F):

Foundation Course is based upon the content that leads to knowledge enhancement. It is mandatory as per course curriculum

• Open Elective (OE):

Open Elective course may be from an unrelated discipline. It is Interdisciplinary/Open Elective of mandatory as per course curriculum.
