Brief Report of Activities of Youth Red Cross, M.D.U. Rohtak for the Session 2013-2014(August 1, 2013 to July31, 2014)

1. University Level Youth Red Cross Awareness Camp/ Workshop for Principals, Y.R.C. Counsellors of various colleges of M.D.U. Rohtak.

A one day university level Youth Red Cross awareness camp/ workshop for Principals and Y.R.C. Counsellors of M.D.U. Rohtak, was organized on 12-9-2013 in DDE Hall, M.D.U. Rohtak, in collaboration with Indian Red Cross Society Haryana State Branch, Chandigarh. The workshop was inaugurated by Er. H. S. Chahal, Vice-Chancellor, M.D.U. Rohtak and presided over by Dr. Y.S. Khyalia, I.A.S., Commissioner, Hisar Division. Principals and Y.R.C. Counsellors participated in this camp.

The main focus of the workshop/ Seminar was on to create awareness regarding Youth Red Cross activities at university and college level. Introduction of First Aid, Disaster Management, voluntarism in youth and use of YRC fund and importance of blood donation were some of the topics highlighted by the different resource persons. 









































6. Health Awareness Training camp for YRC volunteers (Girls) at Udaipur.


