REPORT OF YRC ACTIVITIES, UNIVERSITY YOUTH RED CROSS

(Session: 2014-15)

1. Meeting of Youth Red Cross Committee M.D. University Rohtak.

A meeting of Youth Red Cross Committee M.D. University Rohtak was held on 2-9-2014 under the Chairmanship of Er. H.S. Chahal, the then Vice Chancellor cum Chairman Youth Red Cross Committee, M.D. University Rohtak in the conference hall of Vice Chancellor's office The Programme Co-ordinator Youth Red Cross Committee welcomed the Chairman and other members. The Chairman released the Bulletin of Information and brief report of Youth Red Cross for the year 2013-2014. The Chairman and members appreciated the initiative taken by Programme Co-ordinator for bringing out this bulletin. The Programme co-ordinator gave a brief power point presentation relating to the Youth Red Cross and its activities which was appreciated by all.. In addition to this income and expenditure for the year 2013-2014, tentative Budget, Activity Calendar for year 2014-2015, and other resolutions were approved in the meeting. Meeting was attended by 17 members including Zonal Conveners and Hony. Secretary Indian Red Cross Society Haryana State Branch Chandigarh.


7. World Aids Day Awareness Campaign.

8. First Aid and Home Nursing Training to M.D. University Youth Red Cross Volunteers.








10. Celebration of 'Rastriya Yuva Diwas' on 12-1-2015.

To recognise the services rendered by Swami Vivekanand to the nation, a state level function was




16 University level workshop on Health & Hygiene (Regarding Health, Hygiene and Pain management) for YRC Counsellor and Volunteers.


